Mitiz is my first horse. I bought her as an untrained five year old, mostly because she was beautiful. She is 15 hands, chestnut with a blaze, hind stockings, and a flaxen mane and tail.

She went on her first ride, the Kettle Moraine 25 in 1974 as a seven year old two months after she had a foal. She won the ride. In 1976 she was UMECRA Competitive Reserve Lightweight Champion. Mitiz has been in the UMECRA Top Ten each year she has competed.

Mitiz is extremely smooth gaited. She is a very 'trail wise' horse who knows how to get over a trail safely and expends very little energy doing it. She is now being used as a broodmare. Her foals appear to show many of her qualities of strength and tenacity.
