Tell us about yourself (job, family, etc.):

Tali: Married for 16 years to my husband Dennis. We have one son 9 years old, Devin. I work at Haworth in Douglas, Michigan. Give riding lessons on the side.

Terri: I work as an accountant for a nonprofit organization in Northeast Minneapolis. My husband Jay and I live on a 10 acre hobby farm just north of Elk River with our five dogs, 2 barn cats, and three horses. We have a son, Jason who lives in Wisconsin with his wife and three children.

Taryn: Veterinarian and certified veterinary acupuncturist. I've just started my own house-call/farm-call acupuncture-only practice, Serenity Veterinary Acupuncture in Duluth, Minnesota. My family is my 3 dogs: Berlin, Kelso & Killian, and 3 horses: Red, Rhio, & Cricket.

T.J.: Retired in 2003 as Conservation Warden Supervisor for the Upper St. Croix Basin Law Enforcement Team. Presently a Christmas Tree Farmer. Married to my first wife for 33 years. Two daughters: Katheryn who is a police canine officer and Margaret who got me into riding and has managed to keep me broke.

How did you get involved in distance riding?

Tali: I met a neighbor Julie Roe who introduced distance riding to me. I didn't know how lucky I was to live so close {7 miles} to such a legend of this sport. She taught me all I know.

Terri: My neighbor Bev Specht bugged me for years to try it- I finally did because I wanted to ride my horses more than I was.

Taryn: My friend, training buddy, and transportation to rides - Jodi Johannessen - got me started/addicted to this great sport. My first season competing was 2004.

T.J.: I started riding in 1996 and in '99 I was doing some long and fast trail rides with some local ladies that had gone to 2-3 endurance rides. They told me about endurance riding and it piqued my interest. In 2000 I went to the Sand Dunes Ride and did two comp rides and was hooked.

Are you a ride manager or a rider? Tell us about the ride you manage or the horse/mule you compete.

Tali: I've not yet managed a ride; however, I would like to some day. I have 3 Arabs that I'm competing this year. Pro Caliber who was once a show horse for western pleasure. Phoenix, I've had since he was a baby. Last but not least LA Accelant who was a country english pleasure horse who didn't like his job. Seems to enjoy the trail so far.

Terri: I have two Arabian geldings that I compete with. Jaq is a long legged chestnut with white socks. He is a blast to ride with

a big trot. He just goes down the trail not really paying attention to much of anything. Legacy (Leggs) is a beautiful bay originally trained for halter showing but adapting quite well to competitive riding. I call him my what can I do for you today horse because he is so willing to do whatever I ask.

Taryn: I'm a rider, but maybe someday I will also be a ride manager. I hope to have at least another 30 years in this sport, so who knows what the future will bring? I mainly compete with my gelding, Red. He's a 13 year old chestnut Half-Arabian gelding with a lot of spook (unfortunately) and a lot of heart (fortunately). We especially love woods trails and new trails we haven't seen before. My younger gelding, Rhio, competed in 2007 and will hopefully do so again in 2009.

T.J.: Just a rider but don't mind helping out at rides if asked. Presently riding JBK Tara, an 11 y.o. Anglo/Arabian mare and Miss Molly Mule, a 6 y.o. appy-cross. Tara had colic surgery in 2006 and almost died. She has done very well this season in spite of her rider.

What separates a really good ride from a just-OK one?

Tali: I think the difference in a good ride from just OK isn't only the trail. To me it is the management. Good spirits and being polite make an ok ride into a GREAT one.

Terri: I can only imagine the amount of work it takes to put on a ride so my thanks go out to all the ride managers for the effort they give for us to have a great weekend. I think the more organization there is the better. Things just seem to flow and for me that's a really good ride.

Taryn: A really good ride for me is one in which my horse and I stay upright & connected for the duration of the ride, and finish feeling well and happy. Mostly those are cooler-season rides, as the hot rides drag both of us down. If you were to ask Red, he would say any ride that he doesn't have to trot into the rain is a really good ride (rain on the butt is ok, rain on the face is not ok).

T.J.: The rider manager is probably the most important single entity that makes a really good ride. UMECRA is very fortunate in that we have a plethora of excellent ride managers. All of our rides are really good. There are no bad rides, just some that are different. Rides are always what you make them...if you think a ride won't be good it probably won't be. Go to a ride thinking positively and you'll have a good time. Remember, endurance riding is the most fun that you'll ever have with our clothes on!

What advice can you give other riders or ride managers?

Terri: I don't feel like I've been doing this long enough to give advice I'm still trying to take it. I like watching and listening to what others are doing. I'm still in the learning stage. Especially this year competing with two horses that are so different in size and temperament.

Taryn: Use tent stakes (or something) to firmly attach your portable dog crate to the ground before you walk away with your horse to vet in, or you may end up with the dog in the crate tumbling after you. (some of you may remember this event from MnDRA 1 several years ago - I never travel without those tent stakes now!)

T.J.: Don't take competition too seriously. Have fun. Enjoy the moment. Remember that your horse has to come first. Pick a good mentor and listen to her!

What do you wish someone had told you when you first started?

Tali: When I first started distance riding I wish someone could have taught me patience. Not a

month or two but YEARS !! PERSEVERE

Terri: That if I kept up with this I would have to give up my trail horse Tsamari.

Taryn: That gas prices were going to get so high - I could have started saving my pennies for rides a lot sooner!

T.J.: Someone should have told me that if I didn't start listening to the advice I was getting that I couldn't ride any more. The advice was generally "slow down" and "take better care of your horse."

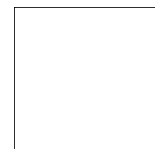
