Ride Managers: **Deadlines—December 15**

If you are going to manage a UMECRA sanctioned ride next year (2009), you will need to **complete the insurance form** that is on the UMECRA website and send it to Jill, UMECRA Secretary/Treasurer before December 15, 2008. Once the form is received by Jill, you will receive a confirmation via email, phone call or post card. No insurance will be placed on any ride or clinic without this form being completed and sent in.

Also, please **contact Elinore Tonsor, Sanctioning Coordinator**, by December 15 if you are planning to sponsor a ride next year. All ride managers need to do this so that their rides can be approved at the annual meeting, but it's particularly important if you want to have a new ride or change the date for an existing ride. Elinore will be mailing sanctioning packets to those who managed a ride last year.

It's also time to start thinking about voting delegates for the annual meeting. These names will need to be provided to Jill Feller before the meeting (but not by December 15).

No Rider Rep Elections This Year

All rider reps were elected to a two-year term last year, so there will be no rider rep ballots mailed this year.

When submitting your nomination, please include a description of the horse's accomplishments and the reason you are nominating the horse. This nomination will appear in the UMECRA convention program and might be the basis for people making their selection. Nominations should be submitted to Elinore Tonsor (contact info. on back cover.)

UMECRA High Point Senior Equines

Congratulations to all of the equines 20 years of age and older that were nominated for the new High Point Senior Equine award this year. These "experienced" steeds aren't just sitting around in the pasture gathering dust (and put many of us creaky, ibuprofen-laden riders to shame!) Here are some 2008 statistics you might find interesting:

- 15 elderly steeds were nominated.
- 9 of them completed at least one ride in 2008.
- As a group, these nine racked up 2, 214 miles and 781.6 points.
- The oldest nominated (27) was Joslyn Seefeldt's Dude.
- The oldest (24) to complete a ride was Dawn Haas' NW's Eklipse.
- The senior equine with the highest 2008 mileage was 21-year old Syn-erator (Barb Kurti), with 490 miles.
- Five senior equines won at least one first place.
- 21-year old Miska Sohn Sharif (rider: Brooke Koehn) completed 7 endurance rides of at least 50 miles.

We hope to see these horses out on the trail again in 2009!

Ken Carpenter Thrown

A 57-year-old Fort Atkinson man was hospitalized over the weekend after being thrown from his horse when a turkey spooked it in the Kettle Moraine State Forest, the Sheboygan County Sheriff's Department reported Monday.

Ken Carpenter was riding with his wife about 2:10 p. m. Saturday when a wild turkey ran across their path on a trail near Spring Valley Drive and county Highway T in the Town of Greenbush, said Capt. Dave Adams. Carpenter and his wife, Julie, 49, were both thrown from their horses.

Ken Carpenter experienced tingling and loss of feeling on one side and reported a hip and back injury, Adams said. He was taken out of the forest by a Greenbush Fire Department all-terrain vehicle and then transported by ambulance to St. Agnes Hospital in Fond du Lac.

Julie Carpenter was not hurt.

The horses ran off but were later captured near the Wade House.

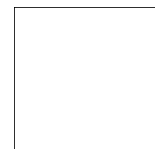
