We have had a few members that have volunteered for some of the open positions on the Board of Directors for next year and I urge you all to take a look and see if you may be able to fit one of them into your schedule. Peggy Passillas has expressed her interest in being the newsletter editor. Angie Mikkleson has volunteered to be the pointskeeper. Shelly Sentyrz has also raised her hand for either position and is willing to help where needed. Ladies, thank you! If anyone is interested please contact any BOD member and we will get you on the ballot.


There have been some questions on the requirements for the Charles Phillips Versatility Award. The criteria for eligibility for the **Charles Phillip Versatility Award**:

- One horse/rider team must complete the following:
 - o Two endurance rides of 50 miles or more in length
 - o Two open competitive rides (25 or more miles) or two competitive drives (20 or more miles in length)
 - o Two limited distance rides of 25 miles or more in length
- Points will be accumulated in the following manner:
 - o 1st place = 7 points
 - o 2nd place = 6 points
 - o 3rd place = 5 points
 - o 4th place = 4 points
 - o 5th place = 3 points
 - o 6th place = 2 points
 - o Completion = 1 point
- Riders must notify the UMECRA points keeper (Barb Gardner) before the beginning of the last ride of the season that you want to be considered for this award. UMECRA members that **do not notify** the points keeper **prior to the last ride will not be eligible** for the award. *(continued on last page)*

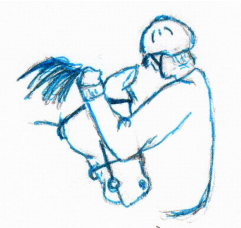

Planning to Attend the National Competitive or Endurance Ride?

- The AHA National Competitive Trail Ride is October 3-4 in Keithburg, IL (entries due by Sept. 12 to avoid late fee.)
- The AHA/AERC National Endurance Ride is October 16-18 in Henryville, IN.
- An AHA competition card is required—you can get this through AHDRA. It is not the same as an associate membership.
- Entry qualification is 100 recognized* miles for the competitive trail ride or 300 recognized* miles for the 100 mile endurance ride/200 for the 50 mile endurance. There are also some other ways to qualify via Top 5 or Top 10 at an AHA Regional or National Ride—see AHA website for details.
*These do not need to be miles in an AHA local or regional ride. See AHA website for details. If you're thinking about doing the ride, you probably qualify.
- **Please note that these are not UMECRA-sanctioned rides and do not count for UMECRA points.** For more information on these rides, go to www.arabianhorses.org, click on the "Competitions" bar at the top of the page, then select "National Events" and endurance or competitive trail ride. 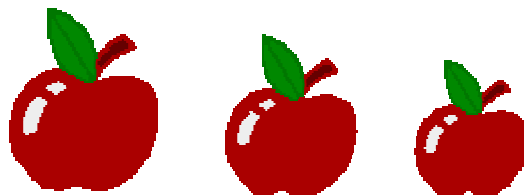

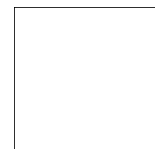
Is UMECRA the "governing" body of the Midwestern Distance Rides?
