4. Any horse, for any reasons, the nominator admires and feels is a superior representative of the "Distance Horse."

When submitting your nomination, please include a description of the horse's accomplishments and the reasons why you are nominating the horse. There is a form on the UMECRA website under the Awards tab, then go to Rider's Choice. Or you can just mail or email your nomination. NEW AERC MEMBERS ELIGIBLE FOR HEART RATE MONITOR DRAWING

For trail riders who wish their rides didn't end at five or 10 miles, endurance riding is the perfect next endeavor. "Our rides range from 25 to 100 miles, and our motto is 'to finish is to win'," said American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC) Executive Director Kathleen Henkel. "Many fit trail horses are certainly capable of finishing one of the shorter distance rides, and the satisfaction that riders get from completing an AERC ride is incomparable."

To welcome riders new to the sport, AERC is offering a drawing for a new Polar® Inzone Equine Heart Rate Monitor, sponsored by EquineMonitors.com, for brand-new members who join by January 1, 2011. Using a heart rate monitor is popular with distance riders as it allows them to exercise their horses within a specific target heart rate zone.

The organization's national office is in Auburn, California, home of the first modern endurance ride, the Western States Trail Ride, more often known as the Tevis Cup.

The "NEW" Oak Leaf Run

Three weeks before the Oak Leaf Run Ride was scheduled to be held, I received a phone call that the ride was cancelled. Under doctor's orders, the manager could not manage the ride due to lung cancer. I had to act quickly to make my decision.

Within a couple days I was a ride manager with no prior experience at a new ride location. I started making phone calls and sent out e-mails. Shelley Dake agreed to stay as ride secretary. My niece offered to be the photographer. Tim and Lisa Germann would help in the vet area. The vets confirmed that they will be there. How I was going to get...how many awards?? A new ride flyer had to be made up and distributed to get the word out. I needed volunteers for the vet area, spotters, marking trails, supplies for the vet area and trails, food, etc. I just kept making a list along with more phone calls and e-mails.

I've been training on these trails so I knew them well. This is the first year of designated trails at the park and with record rainfall, trail usage was very limited. I had to keep changing my loops. Along

with the rain it became mosquito breeding grounds. The week before the ride the deer flies hatched. I kept telling myself that these are distance riders-they will come. I had a few brave souls and their equine friends help me mark most of the trails two days before the ride in 90 degree heat with humidity (Sara Zwiers, Stephanie Laird and Karen Steffens). Other riders chipped in on Friday to finish (Tali Sorenson, Joanne Coy and Pam Brown).

It was a sense of relief when riders started showing up. I had four new riders. Two completed the 15 mile novice ride, one attempted and one finished the 25LD. I was fortunate that my sister lives close by to run home to get a scale for Best Condition.

Overall the ride went very well. Sunday afternoon as the last trailer was pulling out; there was lightning, thunder and hail. Stephanie Laird and Julie Roe had started unmarking the trail but I still had to finish it. It was a time to reflect that all my efforts and hard work paid off. I was able to give my fellow riders an opportunity to compete and have the Oak Leaf Run Ride continue on.

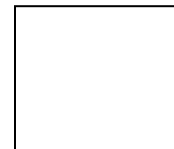
