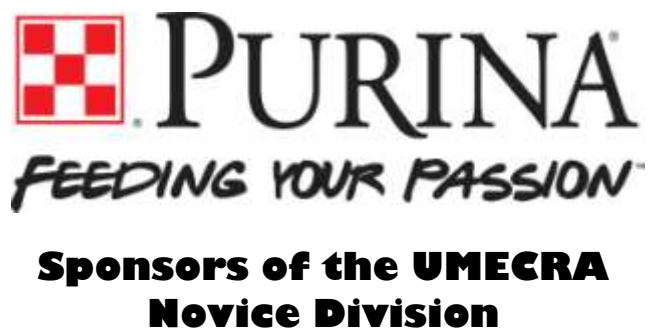

HEALTH CERTIFICATES NOW REQUIRED FOR
IMPORTED HORSES

All horses require a negative test for Equine
Infectious Anemia (EIA) within 12 months prior to
date of importation, unless originating from South
Dakota (rodeo stock are not exempted).
Effective May 24, 2011, a certificate of veterinary
inspection is required for all equines entering North
Dakota for any length of time. There will no longer
be an exemption for equines entering temporarily for
less than 7 days.

Attention: Wildcat Ride Update!

Attention anyone who is planning on riding the 100 mile endurance ride at Wildcat. It is essential that you send your pre-entry along with a check for the ride fee. If I do not receive five (5) pre-paid entries by July 5, we will not hold the 100 mile endurance ride. Endurance Riders need to understand that there is a significant financial commitment to putting on a 100 mile ride, including the hiring of a 3rd veterinarian. You cannot expect ride managers to make that commitment if you are not willing to make a commitment yourself. I WILL NOT CASH YOUR ENTRY CHECK UNTIL AFTER THE RIDE. If I have more than 5 entries and you are unable to attend, I will return your check. If you are unable to enter the 100 at the last minute, but want to enter something else instead, I will apply your check to the other event(s).

A number of people have approached Monna and me asking if we are having the 100. They indicated that they wanted to ride the 100, but "didn't want to make the financial commitment." Well folks, if you're not willing to make the financial commitment, why should we be? We're not budging on this issue. Don't call and ask, just pre-enter and pre-pay because that's the only way to assure that there is a 100 mile endurance ride at Wildcat. Obviously, if there are not 5 pre-paid entries by July 5, than the 100 mile endurance ride will not be held and your checks will be returned. (Please note my new address below.)

The Little Blind Mare

When my mare went blind at the age of three, everyone told me to put her down. What was I, a twelve year old girl, supposed to do? I had only owned her for about three months, and she was my first horse – the horse I had been begging for ever since I could remember.

RR Ghazrael, or Gazy as she was called, was probably not the best choice for a young, beginner rider like me, but as an untrained three year old Arabian mare who had a six month old filly by her side, she was inexpensive and that was the reason my mother chose her.

We still are not sure what caused her blindness, but she went completely blind in a matter of a few weeks. When my mother had noticed her watery eyes, she spoke to a vet who suggested a type of spray to use in her eyes. Her eyes progressively got worse as we used the spray, even though the vet continued to tell us to use it. Three weeks later she was completely blind, and we stopped using the spray.

I was told by several other horse owners and friends to put Gazy down or ship her to slaughter. They tried to convince me that she would never be safe to ride and would be useless as a broodmare. Truthfully, I did consider selling her, but only because I was told by countless people that she was worthless and probably dangerous.

I was handling her every day, and never felt that she was a dangerous horse, she was actually quite calm about most things. So, over the fall and into winter I worked with her getting her used to a saddle and bridle and eventually climbing up on her. My mother would lead us around and Gazy was perfectly fine with someone sitting on her back. When my friends would come over we would groom her, tack her up, and take turns leading each other around. Gazy was

about as broke as any horse, except that she would absolutely not walk out on her own.

One bright and sunny winter day, I decided to show Gazy that she could walk without needing someone to lead her. I saddled and bridled her and led her out to the middle of her two acre pasture, pointed her back towards the barn and climbed on. I nudged her with my legs to ask her to walk, just like I always did when I was being led on her. She stood perfectly still. I nudged a little harder. Still no forward inclination whatsoever. I kicked. I jabbed. Still nothing from Gazy other than a grunt as my heels hit her ribs. I kicked as hard as a twelve-year-old girl wearing snow pants and slightly-too-big winter boots could kick. I still had a not-budging-from-this-spot mare under me.

So I brought out my secret weapon: two Fleet Farm riding crops. With one in each hand, I nudged Gazy with my legs and clucked to her. Just like I expected, she didn't move. WHACK! with both crops on her flanks. She was startled just enough to lose her balance and take a step. "GOOD GIRL!!" I praised her and pet her neck. FINALLY A STEP!! Another nudge with my heels again produced no forward motion, so again WHACK! with the two crops, and again, another startled step. "GOOD GAZZY!!" with more petting. Eventually I consistently got a step from Gazy, then two steps, then three. And within a few minutes we were walking back to the barn!

That was the turning point in our riding. After I could get her to walk wherever I asked in her pasture, I started walking her down our road. Spring was just beginning, the weather was getting better, and I was riding her nearly every day. We started trotting, and a few weeks later, cantering. Gazy would go anywhere I asked her to.

I did everything with Gazy. I showed her at our county fair, we went on trail rides, we went to the Black Hills of South Dakota for a two week riding vacation, I trained her to drive, and I even rode her five miles into town to visit my best childhood friend a few times.

Even though Gazy and I had a great relationship, in my heart I had always wanted to learn how to jump and I knew that was the one thing that Gazy could not do. When I was in my late teens I was introduced to Dressage and began taking lessons on Gazy's daughter, a Belgian/Arab mare named Lacy.

Through the years I learned more about Dressage on several horses and improved my riding with lessons,

and eventually did try some Eventing with other horses as well.

When Gazzy was about 15, I bred her to Hilda Gurney's Trakehner stallion Leonidas, with the hopes that the foal would be my next Dressage and Eventing horse. I had Gazzy inspected and she was approved for breeding by both the American Trakehner Association and the International Sporthorse Registry/Oldenburg Registry North America.

Gazzy foaled a chestnut colt by Leonidas, who I named Lederhosen (Hosen). A few years later I bred Gazzy to an Oldenburg stallion and the resulting foal was a filly, Greta.

I rarely rode Gazzy during these past 12 or so years, but the few times that I did, it was like she had been ridden yesterday. She was always good and I usually used her when taking out my youngsters or green horses because Gazzy is my "old reliable".

When a friend of mine suggested that I try a Novice endurance ride, I originally thought of riding Hosen, though he was fairly green at the time. I didn't go on that ride, which was in the fall of 2010, but I did think about it over winter, and one day just before the New Year, it hit me like a ton of bricks – why couldn't Gazzy do a novice ride?

December 31st last year was an unusually warm winter day with just a slight drizzle falling. I decided to take Gazzy out for a fun ride down the road, bareback and with just a halter. I only rode for about a mile, but boy did that mile bring back memories! Gazzy isn't as well trained as her son, Hosen, but she is still a blast to ride!

Thus began our conditioning program. Gazzy is now 22 years old, and though she has always been sound, I conditioned her slowly. I started with just a mile or two, riding on the nicer winter days, when the roads weren't too icy. By the time mid-April came around we were ready for our first Novice ride, which was to be Iron Oak. Unfortunately, Iron Oak was canceled so our debut at Novice was at the Glacier Trails ride in Palmyra in May.

Gazzy was very nervous at Glacier Trails, and I had to hold her back the entire 12 miles! I was sure she wouldn't pulse down enough at the final vet check, but she came within the parameters, and we scored 360 points. Imagine my surprise when my name was called for first place! I was certain that there was a

scoring error! The ride managers assured me that the scoring was correct and Gazzy and I were in fact first place in the Novice ride.

I swear I floated on air for a week! I didn't think endurance riding would be my "thing" but I think all you guys have another convert on your hands!

Feeding Behavior: What's Natural for Your Horse?

Your fat horse, skinny horse, high-energy horse, and laminitic horse all have different dietary needs; so how do you design a feeding program that mimics how horses' feeding habits have evolved? According to Andrea D. Ellis, BSc, PhD, senior lecturer in equine science and leader of the MSc program in Equine Health and Welfare at Nottingham Trent University's School of Animal, Rural and Environmental Sciences, in Nottinghamshire, England, everyone from equine nutritionists to horse owners can learn something from examining a horse's natural feeding behavior and optimizing diets based on that knowledge. She presented on the topic at the 2011 Alltech International Animal Health and Nutrition Industry Symposium, held May 22-25 in Lexington, Ky.

In order to understand why horses act the way they do when food's involved, Ellis said, "The origin of feeding behavior and how it relates to digestive physiology must be understood."

Ellis explained that a horse's natural feeding behavior is triggered by "physiological changes and signals, such as hormones, nerve signals, and homeostatic mechanisms" that induce a hungry feeling in the animal. "These then lead to a strong motivation to carry out the required behavior, such as lowering the head, sniffing, tasting, chewing, swallowing, and foraging," she added.

Researchers have observed that free-ranging horses (i.e., those feeding in a "natural" manner) generally have 10 to 15 "distinct feeding bouts" in a 24-hour span, and tend to spend 10 to 14 hours per day foraging. Ellis noted that "nonfeeding" bouts typically last for an hour or two and rarely exceed three hours.

So how does this compare to the feeding behavior of a domesticated horse that might spend much of his day in a stall?

"In domesticated horses, provision of feed other than pasture is common and often necessary due to a lack of pasture or due to management focused on sporting activities," Ellis explained.

Domesticated horses are often fed two to three times per day with "long fasting periods in between," Ellis noted. She explained that feeding routines such as this can "lead not only to physiological problems (such as stomach ulcers and colic), but also to stress-related problems. Stereotypies--such as windsucking, weaving, and stall/box walking--occur in response to a chronic perception of stress or anxiety (in the horse) caused by the inability to carry out a strong behavioral urge (e.g., chewing, walking, roaming, eating, flight, and social interaction)."

Ideally, Ellis explained, domestic horses should be allowed as much pasture access as possible (unless you need to restrict grazing access for health reasons). In the event that a horse is stabled for large portions of the day, she suggested a few solutions that could allow for more natural feeding behavior:

Offer high levels of low-energy forage;
Avoid set feeding times when possible by implementing a more continuous feeding program, as anticipated feeding times can increase anxiety and stress;

Consider using feed tubs and hay nets that slow down feed intake; and

Present the horse with multiple forage feed stations within the stall to encourage a natural "grazing" movement.

Additionally, Ellis suggested that providing good quality straw bedding (for those horses not prone to impaction colic, as horses might ingest the straw) could keep horses busy. She noted horses on this bedding often spend time rummaging through and exploring the straw.

But ultimately, "horses need to chew," Ellis explained. "It is not just that they are greedy or awkward or annoying - it's an innate behavior. If we don't manage it right, horses will find replacement behaviors (stereotypies) or some become dull and 'give up.' In addition, (chewing) has direct impact on digestive tract health."

Ellis cautioned that all feed changes should be made slowly, especially those involving increased turnout with ample grazing, as too much feed intake can cause colic and other gastrointestinal problems.
