High Point Team Award

Teams will consist of a maximum of five riders (fewer team members is permitted) Teams must be declared Friday Evening Each team member can accrue points in the following ways

Ways to earn Bonus Points

8 Points for each 4 hours of volunteering at the ride 5 Points for each new rider the team brings (this new rider may not have completed an endurance, competitive trail, or novice ride before Bearfoot Boogie and must enter at least one event at Bearfoot Boogie)

3 Points for leading a novice group

3 Points for BC in Endurance or Limited Distance and High Point Competitive Trail 1 Point for each item valued \$15 or more donated to the Bearfoot Boogie Silent Auction (maximum of 3 points possible per rider)

1 Point for Turtle

Rider Points

Camping

Camping fees apply.

Reserve campsites at Minnesota DNR: <u>https://reservemn.usedirect.com/MinnesotaWeb/</u> We will have overflow sites available if you cannot reserve a site. Cell service is limited in camp. This campground has picnic tables, fire rings, water spigots & vault toilets, Shade trees throughout campground. Some electric campsites are available. Generators permitted, but we request shutting them off by 10pm.

Overflow camping and day camping is available in the parking lot adjacent to the equestrian campground. The DNR will provide fire rings and picnic tables in the overflow lot. This is a gravel lot and you will need to tie to your trailer. You can pay for camping at overflow when you check in for the ride or at the ranger station.

Minnesota Trail Pass and Vehicle Passes are required.

Equine containment:

Hi-ties are available at campsites. You may tie to the trailer. Pens must be approved by ride management.

Our canine buddies:

Dogs are welcome, but please check DNR restrictions and requirements. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and you are expected to clean up after your canine buddy.

How to get to the ride

From the west:

Interstate 35, take exit 183 – Hinckley. Travel east from the ramp to MN Highway 48. Continue east for 15 miles. Turn right at the St. Croix State Park Sign onto St. Croix Park Road. Travel south for 5 miles on St. Croix Park Road to the ranger station, 30065 St. Croix Park Road.

From the east:

Take WI State 35 to Danbury. Turn West onto WI State 77, it will turn into MN Highway 48. The Turn for the State Park is 12 miles from Danbury on your left. Travel south for 5 miles on St. Croix Park Road to the ranger station, 30065 St. Croix Park Road

Check in at the ranger station. There you can purchase a camping placard/vehicle pass and trail pass, and firewood.

After the ranger station follow signs to ride camp - turn left, then left again.
