

BOARD OF DIRECTORS
February 1, 1986

The Board of Directors met February 1, 1986 in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. Present were Paul Heberling, Louise Riedel, Ron Schmid, Art Priesz, Dale Scott, and rider representatives JoAnne Gernant, Marsha Achenbach and Ray Gehrig.

Louise Reported that the computer and printer have been installed and are functional.

Art Priesz presented a new rider release form/entry blank which will more clearly define the risks inherent in distance riding. Louise moved to adopt this form. Motion seconded and carried.

Paul moved to revise the limited distance award description as follows: "however once a team (instead of horse) goes over these mileages. . . ." Motion seconded and carried.

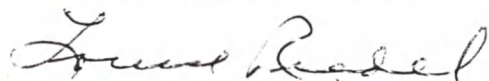
Paul moved to add the AERC Junior policy to the UMECRA rules. Seconded and carried. This will appear on the agenda of the general meeting.

Copies of a proposed by-laws amendment to provide for a veterinarian to be elected to the Board of Directors. Dale moved to put this issue on the agenda for the general meeting. Ron seconded. Motion carried.

A discussion followed as to whether to replace the 72 pulse requirement as a criteria for successful completion. (Rule 1 C 7 b). Ron moved to leave the proposal as it appears in the minutes of the December board meeting. Art seconded. Motion carried. Art moved that if the above amendment does not pass, to delete the "1/2 hour from competitive" and add "does not apply to competitive rides". Ron seconded. Motion carried.

Louise moved that the following be added to the agenda: Rule 1 C 1 shall be changed to read: "Horses must be under veterinary supervision throughout the duration of the event." Paul moved to add to the agenda that Rule 11 D 5 be deleted (Rules affecting veterinary judging may be changed due to unusual ride conditions if deemed necessary by the head veterinarian and a UMECRA board member. Ron seconded. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned.

GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was called to order by president, Paul Heberling. Thirty-one rides were represented as follows: AHDRA I, AHDRA II, ApDRA, Arab Inc, Charity Cup, Copper Country, Four Corners, Glacier Trails, Grand Island I, Hayward, Hennepin County, Gypsy Rover, Hayward, Hennepin County, Jubilee, KMAHA, Kettle Moraine, Michibay, Milwaukee River, Minn-I-Kota, Minnesota River Valley, Mt. Valhalla, Nellisville, Palisades, Pillager, Pillsbury St. Forest, St. Jude, SE Minnesota I, SE Minnesota II, Son of a Ditch, Sunset Valley, Wildcat Mountain, and Wolf Creek. Fifty-two were eligible to vote.

Copies of the 1985 financial report were circulated. Paul announced that new entry blank/release forms had been prepared by Art Priesz and will be included in the ride packet.

JoAnne Gernant moved to accept the following amendment to the By-laws to add a veterinary

representative to the Board of Directors. Bob Wadzinski seconded. Motion carried.

"Proposed Change: Article III - Board of Directors - Section I, as follows:

ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. The property and business of this corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, which shall be composed of delegates, with the exception of the Board position of Veterinarian representative which will be composed of an endurance or competitive ride veterinarian. The Board shall not be less than three in number and not more than nine. The Board shall consist of a president, vice president, secretary/treasurer, Immediate past president, and two members elected at large, or more as may be determined appropriate by majority vote of the Board, up to a maximum of four. There also shall be a Board position of veterinarian representative. Each director shall be elected to serve for one year or until his/her successor shall have been elected and qualified. All directors shall be elected at the annual meeting by majority vote of the attending delegates of the corporation.

JoAnne moved to accept the AERC Junior policy as part of our rules. Dave Zontelli seconded. Motion carried. AERC Junior policy follows:

1. Junior riders shall have their own division within the AERC point system. (Not eligible for first overall or overall best condition)
2. There shall be a junior best condition judged and recognition made if two or more Juniors are competing on the ride. This shall be without regard to the availability of an actual award.
3. Juniors may compete for AERC and UMECRA points and awards within their own division on rides of 50 miles or over.
4. Junior riders may participate in competition only with written consent of parent or guardian.
5. A junior is any young person aged 16 and under as of December 1 of the new ride year. Any junior is required to ride with a sponsor except Juniors from the age of 14 to 16 who have completed 500 AERC sanctioned miles and with the written consent of parents or guardians.
6. Sponsor must be an adult rider over the age of 18 and duly entered as a competitor/participant in the ride. Ride management may allow non-competitor sponsor, when necessary, and junior then shall receive completion only.
7. A sponsor must be registered by name with ride management before the start of the ride and a junior may not change sponsors EXCEPT at regular stated vet checks and then only with knowledge and consent of ride management. The new sponsor must be registered by name and name written on junior rider's vet card or recorded at the time of change. Junior may change sponsors only if sponsor pulled or cannot continue the ride.

JoAnne moved that the proposed change to Rule I C 7 b be rejected. Fred seconded. Motion carried. Tom Pickard moved that the present Rule I C 7 b be amended to read"

✓ "b. For endurance: Have stable vital signs and are showing subjective and objective signs of recovery with a pulse of 72 or less one hour from time of crossing the finish line.

✓ add c. For competitive: Have stable vital signs and are showing subjective and objective signs of recovery.

Renumber present c. and d. to d. and e.

✓ JoAnne moved, Elinore seconded to disregard proposal to change Rule I C 7. Motion carried.

✓ Judy Schlunk moved to accept the change to rule II B 1. Ray Gehrig seconded. Motion defeated.

Bob Wadzinski moved, Ron seconded that the following amendment to rule II B 1 a be approved: "competitive rides using the window system can not offer a stress division."

✓ Louise moved to amend this amendment to the effect that the stress division be eliminated on all rides. Anne seconded. Motion carried 38-14. Louise moved that Rule II B 8 (providing for the stress division) be deleted and rule II B 9 be renumbered to replace it. Motion carried 38-14.

Etta Beecher moved, Carol Wadzinski seconded to change the wording in the suggested amendment of rule B 1 as follows: "If a ride opts to use this systme (window) It should (Instead of must) be announced. . . " Motion carried.

Bob moved, Wes seconded to delete the word "minimim" in II B 1 b 4. Motion carried. Bob moved that the following statement be added to II b 1 B 4: "No plus points shall be awarded for pulse and respiration." Motion carried.

Mike Thomas moved, Virginia Rice seconded to change rule II D 2 b 5 by addign the underlined "A pre-ride pulse and respiration, dehydration and capillary refill should be taken. These readings shall be used as a reference point upon which to determine future readings, but not to award plus points." Dr. Beecher moved, Mike seconded to table the above motion. Motion to table carried. Mike moved, Virginia seconded to allow the Board to reword the score sheets to delete plus points, and as otherwise necessary. Motion carried.

Bob moved, Fred Kuhn seconded to amend Rule III 1 (concerning Stop and Go rides) to eliminate the following: "but must provide notification in the ride brochure or Newsletter." Motion defeated.

Fred moved, Dianne seconded to change rule I C 1 to read "Horses must be under veterinary supervision during the duration of the event." Motion carried.

Bob moved, Monna Radtke seconded to delete Rule II D 5 which reads "Rules affection veterinary Judging may be changed due to unusual ride conditions if deemed necessary by the head veterinarian and a UMECRA bosrd member. Motion carried.

The proposed 1986 ride schedule was distributed. Bob moved and Anne seconded that it be approved. Motion carried. Bob moved, Fred seconded to approve the following new rides: Gypsy Rover, Minn-I-Kota, Bear Down, and Park Falls. Motion carried.

Election of officers followed with these results: Nominated for president - Rick Nelson, Art Priesz, Elinore Tonsor, Dale Scott. Art Priesz elected. Nominated for vice-president - Dr. Beecher, Elinore Tonsor. Dr. Beecher elected. Louise Riedel elected by voice vote for secretary-treasurer. Nominated for four Board of Director positions: Marsha Achenbach, Elinore Tonsor, Dianne Kuhn, Rick Nelson, Peg Bobert, Bonnie Kaufman, Dale Scott, Tom Pickard, Mike Thomas, BobWadzinski. Elected were Marsha Achenbach, Rick Nelson, Tom Pickard and Mike Thomas. Nominated for Veterinary Representative - Dean Peterson. Elected.

The meeting adjourned.

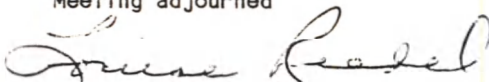
