

BOARD OF DIRECTORS
January 28, 1989

The Board of Directors met at the Holiday Inn, Fond du Lac, at 7:30 a.m. In attendance were Art Priesz, Dee Mielke, Louise Riedel, Dr. Beecher, Ray Gehrig, Paul Heberling, Guy Worthington, Leonard Rounds, and rider representatives Marsha Achenbach, Kathy Love and JoAnne Gernant.

The reading of the minutes of the last meeting were accepted as circulated. Under old business two motions that were passed at the December board meeting were reconsidered because an ineligible person had made one and seconded another. Ray moved and Dr. Beecher seconded the motion that for high point awards, "places will be given through 10th to those who have 40 points or more competitive and 60 points or more endurance." Motion carried. Dr. Beecher moved and Dee seconded the second motion in question to read "Rule III D shall be renumbered to become Rule I D 9" Motion carried.

Dee stated that she had received a number of requests to bring before the general meeting the proposal that a new division be instituted to be called the short distance-open division. This motion had been tabled at the December Board meeting. Louise moved, Dee seconded to remove this issue from the table and present it at the general meeting. Dr. Beecher added a friendly amendment to add "without board approval." Motion as amended carried.

Leonard had received communications from several rides objecting to making UMECRA insurance mandatory. Leonard moved to make this program optional with a deadline date for rides to apply. The cost will be pro-rated among the rides that apply. Dr. Beecher seconded. Motion carried.

A motion had been made at the December board meeting to discontinue giving best condition points for year-end awards. A question was raised whether this should be brought before the general meeting. Dr. Beecher moved not to present the subject. Ray seconded. Motion carried.

A request had been received to add a division for limited distance endurance. There was no motion forthcoming.

Kathy reported having had a suggestion that only twelve rides count for accumulating points for year-end awards. No motion was made. Another suggestion was that there be a board member from each state. This would require a by-law change. After extensive discussion it was decided to study this matter and consider it for next year.

It was recommended that a nominal fee be charged for next year's convention registration to cover the costs of a speaker and other incidental expenses.

The meeting adjourned.

GENERAL MEETING

The general meeting convened at 1:00. Rides represented were AHDRA I, White River Spring, Summer, Fall and Labor Day, KMAHA, Effingham Crossroads I, St. Jude, Scrub Oaks, Grand Island I, Pillsbury State Forest, Ahdra II, Glacier Trails, Hayward, ApDRA, Maplewood, SE Minnesota, Wildcat Mountain, MnDRA I and II, Prairie River, Walkingstick, Charity Cup, Illini, Palisades, Yankee Springs, KM Colorama, AHAM, Mt. Valhalla, Jubilee, Ft. Ridgely, Milwaukee River, AHDRA III, and Point Chaser. Sixty-seven were entitled to vote.

The minutes were approved as circulated. It was moved and seconded to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried. The Newsletter financial report was approved. Elinore Tonsor was thanked for her efforts as Newsletter Editor.

Under Committee Reports, Sue Lodl, a representative of the Wisconsin Horse Trails Council, explained the work of this group.

Lindsay Taliaferro reported on the activities of AERC and explained the 1989 championship system.

Fred Kuhn moved to adopt the 1989 schedule as circulated with the addition of the AHDR III ride on October 21, 22. Motion seconded and carried.

Fred moved to adopt the change recommended by the board as follows "Places will be given through 10th to those who have 40 points or more competitive and 60 or more endurance." Motion seconded and carried.

Sally Worthington moved and Madeline Scott seconded as follows "Rookie of the Year award shall be changed to read 'Awarded in both endurance and competitive to the senior riders with the most points of those riders who have not competed in open rides previous to the current year. This shall be limited to a one rider--one horse combination in each division.'" Motion carried.

Lindsay moved to adopt the following addition to Rule I C 2. "Normal criteria for advancement are a pulse of 68 and a respiration of 68. These criteria must be met at all regularly scheduled vet checks, and on a competitive ride the pulse criteria must be met within 20 minutes at the final check in order to qualify for completion and placing. Motion seconded. Sally moved to amend the motion to read "Mileage credit will be awarded." Elinore seconded. Amendment defeated. Original motion carried.

It was voted to approve the recommendation of the Board to adopt the following change to Rule I D 3 as follows "Entrants must follow the prescribed course, do multiple loops in the correct order, and pass all control points. A competitor who fails this criteria should be pulled from placing but may be allowed a completion, if in the opinion of ride management the violation was not intentional and did not result in making the course easier or shorter. However if the rider wishes to compete for placing then he must go back to the point of departure and must complete the entire trail in its correct order."

Dr. Beecher moved, Bob Wadzinski seconded to change Rules II A b 2 and III A to read All riders must be weighed with tack pre-ride and shall ride in their respective weight divisions." Motion defeated.

Dr. Beecher moved, Fred Kuhn seconded to add the following to Rule II D c "The number of spot checks shall be limited to two per day." Motion defeated unanimously.

Wendy Thiede moved, Mike Thomas seconded to add a short-distance open ride to the competitive division. Motion defeated.

At the December Board meeting a proposal had been considered that a 5 or 10 minute hold check be used at spot checks. The Board voted that the matter be presented at the annual meeting with the Board's recommendation that it not be passed. There being no motion from the floor, the matter was dropped.

The subject of UMECRA obtaining a blanket insurance policy was presented. Rick Nelson moved that UMECRA provide optional insurance with fees to be pro-rated among rides that apply. Motion seconded and carried.

The next order of business was election of officers. Nominated for president were Art Priesz; JoAnne Gernant, declined; Ray Gehrig, declined; Jan Worthington. Art was elected. Nominated for Vice President were Dee Mielke and Guy Worthington. Dee was elected. Louise Riedel was nominated for Secretary and elected by acclamation. Nominated for Board members at large were Leonard Rounds, Dr. Beecher, Joe Yogus, Mark Jensen, Ray Gehrig, Connie Gray, Wendy Thiede, Monna Radtke, Wayne McVeigh and Guy Worthington. Elected were Leonard Rounds, Dr. Beecher, Ray Gehrig and Guy Worthington. Nominated for Veterinary Representative were Randy Schuett, Sharon Kiehm, Vic Cortese and Wel Elford. Sharon Kiehm was elected.

The meeting was adjourned
