

BOARD MEETING

November 3, 2001

The UMECRA Board of Directors met at noon, November 3, in Dubuque, Iowa. Present were Mary Mott, Lori Windows, Linda Mowrer, Wes Elford, Dale Lunde, Elinore Tonsor, Wayne Gastfield, Bonnie Mielke, Roberta Harms, Rick Nelson, Louise Riedel and June Scheunemann, Newsletter editor.

Louise reported a balance of \$12,551.07 in the checking account. Rick moved, Wayne seconded to accept the treasurer's report. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Mary reported on a protest, which was not upheld. It concerned the case of a competitive ride where pre-ride points were entered on the score sheet and deducted at the end. It also dealt with the breaking of a tie by deducting .5 point.

Mary will make a statement at the general meeting to clarify the issue of tie breaking. (According to UMECRA Rule E.3 ties shall not be broken)

Regarding the Score Sheet--Lori stated she thought it was successful when used as it was designed (no pre-ride deductions entered for lameness) Discussion followed as to the use of the score sheet especially regarding pre-ride deductions for lameness/way of going. Wes moved that pre-ride lameness and fatigue observations/scores will be deducted from post-ride scores. Elinore seconded. Motion carried 6 - 4 with 1 abstention. Wes will develop a replacement score sheet to be presented to the Board before the general meeting.

Louise stated that giving the rider representatives the right to vote at Board meetings necessitates a By-law change. She will research the rules and present a proposal at the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Dale moved to present to the general meeting a proposed rule that UMECRA break ties by averaging the points in ENDURANCE rides for horses that tie. Wes seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Elinore requested clarification concerning the requirement that a veterinarian be on the grounds. There is no rule covering this.

Wes moved to form a Protest Committee, consisting of up to 5 members the chairman to be the UMECRA vice president. Dale seconded. Carried unanimously Suggested procedures: The committee shall include the director from that area, a ride manager, a rider representative and the veterinary representative. The committee will be appointed at the annual meeting. This committee will hear all protests and will make a ruling within a month. The chairman will obtain all pertinent information from the protestor, the protestee, the ride manager, veterinarian and director from that area, The committee's decision will be brought back to the Board with all relevant material. The Board will decide whether the protest is upheld or denied.

Elinore reported that the internet contains obsolete material that should be deleted. The President will contact Peggy Brush relevant to removing this material. She feels that the website should include the Board of Directors, also the name of a contact person from UMECRA. June will contact Peggy regarding this.

Elinore distributed projected schedules of ride dates for the next five years.

Elinore moved that General Rule 1e be changed to limit the number of rides to two per weekend (exception: Established 3-ride weekends) Motion failed 4 - 6.

Lori moved that the following be added to the Ride Manager's Handbook as C 1 d under General Suggestions: on waterless trails water should be made available at about 6 miles on a 12-mile loop .

Roberta moved that the following be added to the Ride Manager's Handbook as C 1 e under General Suggestions: if weather conditions warrant it, on competitive rides an extra bucket should be allowed for sponging. Dale seconded. Motion carried 8-2.

Elinore moved to establish a formula to determine the amount spent on top ten year-end awards as follows: \$2.50 per UMECRA member ride entry from the preceding year. Bonnie seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Rick moved to allocate 50% of the above amount for Rookie and Restricted mileage awards. Lori seconded. Motion carried.

Louise announced that as a result of an AERC ruling last year there will be no more discounts in the nomination fees for re-sanctioned rides. All rides, whether new or old, will pay the same fee.

Wes moved to establish a UMECRA Hall of Fame award with money from the general fund not to exceed \$500. Roberta seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Elinore volunteered to research a source for the award.

DRAW will contribute 50% of the cost of the upcoming convention reception, the remainder to come from UMECRA or one of the other affiliated organizations. Tentatively AHDRA will take care of it for this convention.

Dale moved that UMECRA switch to the AERC weight divisions. Motion died for lack of a second.

Elinore questioned the fact that the scholarship fund states that the 25 qualifying rides must be ridden as a junior, which eliminates most adults from eligibility.

Rick moved to adjourn. Motion carried.
