

BOARD MEETING

November 8, 2003

The UMECRA Board of Directors met at the home of Louise Riedel in Dubuque, IA . President Linda Mowrer called the meeting to order. Also present were Darlene Molitor, Louise Riedel, Dawn Haas, Rick Nelson, ayne Gastfield, Joyce Mocilan, Wes Elford, Roberta Harms, Dale Lunde, June Scheunemann, and Mike Bernsdorf.

The minutes of the January 11, 2003 annual meeting were read. Rick moved, Dale seconded to approve. Carried. The financial report as of November 1 showed a balance on hand of \$9898.96. Rick moved, Wayne seconded to accept the finance report. Carried. A comparison between 2002 and 2003 showed an appreciable decrease in membership, while other accounts remained approximately the same, with 2002 standing at \$10,262 and 2003 at \$9898. Tabled.

NEW BUSINESS. Pulse parameters. The rule covering pulse parameter of 68 for competitive will be enforced. This will be brought to the meeting. Joyce moved to change pulse to a recommended minimum of 60 for endurance and LD. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

A discussion followed concerning the reasons for the decline in membership . It was suggested that a financial committee be established, to include Wes, Louise, Linda, Joyce

Roberta addressed the letter from Lori with some riders' concerns, namely: competitive horses' failure to meet parameters of 68 . The fact that this remains a rule should be brought to convention

Rick addressed the problem of "buddy" horses, especially as it relates to AERC rules, which differ from ours. In his opinion this issue should be brought to the AERC board. Rick moved to write a letter to the Rules Committee, AERC, Roberta seconded. Motion carried.

Changing the location of the banquet. Dianne is in charge of next banquet.

Dianne would like to see the format of the 1000 mile horse awards altered. It will be brought to the attention of the membership. A new supply of 1000 mile horse awards has just arrived. Moved to bring the issue to the membership, seconded and carried. Dale moved to bring elimination of the rider mileage chevrons to the general meeting. Wes seconded. Carried.

Dianne is in charge of major awards consisting of jackets, blankets and certificates for top ten. Minor awards (shirts) for Restricted mileage, and rookie. Joyce moved, Roberta seconded that amount spent for year end awards be no more than 75% of the Balance on Hand. Motion carried

It was suggested that the boxes of ride supplies be assembled and distributed at convention. Louise will investigate cost of equineent@lakefield.net forms; Joyce will write letters to ride managers asking them to estimate the numbers of forms they will need.

Moved to reduce rookie endurance and rookie competitive awards to one each for 2004. Seconded by Rick. Carried.

Louise moved to reduce restricted mileage to 5 placings per year. Seconded & carried.

The next order of business was consideration of the 2004 schedule, which will appear elsewhere in the Newsletter

The minutes of the January 11, 2003 annual meeting were read. Rick moved, Dale seconded to approve. Carried. The financial report as of November 1, 2003 showed a balance on hand of \$9,898.96. Rick moved, Wayne seconded to accept the finance report. Motion carried. A comparison between 2002 and 2003 showed an appreciable decrease in membership, while other accounts remained approximately the same, with 2002 standing at \$10,262 and 2003 at \$9,898.96. Tabled.

New Business

Pulse parameters. The rule covering pulse parameter of 68 for competitive will be enforced. This will be brought to the meeting. Joyce moved to change pulse to a recommended minimum of 60 for endurance and LD. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

A discussion followed concerning the reasons for the decline in membership. It was suggested that a financial committee be established, to include Wes, Louise, Linda and Joyce.

Roberta addressed the letter from Lori with some riders' concerns, namely: competitive horses failure to meet parameters of 68. The fact that this remains a rule should be brought to convention.

Rick addressed the problem of "buddy" horses especially as it relates to AERC rules, which differ from ours. In his opinion, this issue should be brought to the AERC Board. Rick moved to write a letter to the Rules Committee, AERC. Roberta seconded. Motion carried.

Changing the location of the banquet. Dianne is in charge of next banquet.

Dianne would like to see the format of the 1,000-mile horse awards altered. It will be brought to the attention of the membership. A new supply of 1,000-mile horse awards has just arrived. Moved to bring the issue to the membership, seconded and carried. Dale moved to bring elimination of the rider mileage chevrons to the general meeting. Wes seconded. Motion carried.

Dianne is in charge of major awards consisting of jackets, blankets and certificates for top ten. Minor awards (shirts) for restricted mileage and rookie. Joyce moved, Roberta seconded that amount spent for year-end awards be no more than 75% of the balance on hand. Motion carried.

It was suggested that the boxes of ride supplies be assembled and distributed at convention. Louise will investigate the cost of forms; Joyce will write letters to ride managers asking them to estimate the numbers of forms they will need.

Moved to reduce rookie endurance and rookie competitive awards to one each for 2004. Seconded by Rick. Motion carried.

Louise moved to reduce restricted mileage to five placings per year. Seconded and carried.

The final order of business was consideration of the 2004 schedule.

Owned by Louise Riedel

Tutsyn+ (Tutty) was born on May 15, 1983 in Mr. Vernon, Missouri. On August 6, 1993, Tutty received the *Purebred Legion of Honor Award*. At that time only around 1,600 horses in the United States and Canada qualified for it. On January 8, 1998, Tutty received the *Purebred Legion of Supreme Honor Award*. As of 2004, Tutsyn+ is retired with over 6,000 miles.

Mid-season this year, my horse RCF Blade Runner, began having major back pain and underwent different treatments, none of which were successful. I was without a horse to complete the season. As soon as Louise heard, she immediately volunteered Tutty for me to ride. I took her up on the offer and brought him to *Endure for the Cure* with very little conditioning. Tutty was so happy to be back out on the trails, he completed fifty miles, placing 2nd and 5th. After that, I decided to leave Blade off for the rest of the season and finish the season with Tutty. By the end of the season, Tutty and I completed 470 miles in eight rides. This included *Shore to Shore*, with two *Best of Breeds*, and two *Reserve Champions*. He also placed 1st in the three-day hundred at *Wildcat*. Competing at only eight rides, Tutty received *Reserve Champion* at *UMECRA*, and 3rd in *AHDRA*. More importantly, Tutty helped me to forget about my bad luck earlier in the season, which was hard for me.

Tutty is now retiring at Chapel Hill Farm at the age of twenty, where he is going to teach junior riders all about endurance and competitive riding. Tutty is always very willing to go down the trail with his ears forward and tail "wagging". You will see Tutty around taking juniors and showing them the way down the trail. He will also always be around to take Louise (who is very proud of him this year) down the trail. So please, vote for Tutty for his hard work and willing attitude. This will be a great ending to his career.

Zalmara Din

Owned and Ridden by Candy Barbo

Nominated by Anita Sinnott

Most of us have either read the book or seen the movie "Seabiscuit" and recognize it as a story of inspiration, faith and heart. Seabiscuit achieved success beyond the wildest dreams of those that believed in him. This story of a legendary horse captured each and everyone in a very special and personal way. It certainly made me think of one of UMECRA's own.

So with this in mind, I respectfully nominate another amazing horse, Zalmara Din (Mara), for this year's UMECRA's Horse of the Year Award. Mara, like Seabiscuit, had a very difficult start in life. She came to the Candy and Ed Barbo family as a boarder horse following a series of very unfortunate experiences. Her overall condition was so poor, that Candy insisted that a veterinarian examine her before she would agree to even keep her there. At that point, Mara's survival was in question; she was extremely thin, appeared malnourished and was obviously weak. Following veterinary treatment, guidance and care, Mara began to thrive. Candy's efforts and commitment were soon rewarded with the opportunity to call Mara her own. There was no question that she would now be a member of the ever-growing Barbo horse family. Not only did Mara prove to be an "easy keeper", but a joy to ride as well.

Based on her strong recovery, it was time to consider training for the next summer's events in Canada. Fall, winter and spring strengthening and conditioning paid off. Her performance in this first competition established the base for an amazing record in the sport of endurance riding. In addition to placing in many sweepstakes rides, Mara has been top ten in *MNDRA*, *UMECRA*, *AHDRA* or *AERC* every year since she started. Last year she was *AHDRA's Winner of the Versatility Award* and this year, *Endurance Champion*. She excels in 100 milers with the ability to take care of herself, pace according to conditions and demonstrate enough "attitude and competitiveness to make it fun. Mara has also participated in and successfully completed the last two *Pan American Games*. In 2001, she placed 11th in Vermont and in 2003, she was 17th at Mount Adams, Washington. To top off this year's accomplishments, Mara has been named to the *National Traveling Team* in preparation for possible participation as a *USA Endurance Team member in the World Championship* in Dubai next year.

Mara continues to excel in her role as a true endurance horse; not only does she accept the challenge of the course, but adjusts to extreme changes in her environment and stays "sound". She has completed over 3,500 endurance miles, not to mention competitive rides to "fill in the gaps". She has met each and every challenge with the heart of a real champion. In fact, Mara's strengths go beyond the world of horses; she is also considered trustworthy, extremely gentle and respectful of those that love and care for her.

Seeing Mara today, beautiful and strong, one would find it hard to believe that obstacles she has overcome to reach the status of a "once in a lifetime" dream come true endurance race horse.

Indigo Moon

Owned, Ridden and Nominated by Nancy Wilson

I would like to nominate my horse, Indigo Moon (Blue), for the 2003 Rider's Choice Award. Blue is a 15-year-old registered half Arabian palomino paint. He has overcome a sprained tendon in both front legs and a winter of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease to remain in the year-end awards each of the five years we have competed in *GLDRA* and *UMECRA*.

In the summer of 1996, Blue suffered a moderate middle tendon bow of his right front leg after a dressage training session when a large rock lodged in his right front hoof. After seven months of rehabilitation, Blue resumed dressage training and competed at training level for two years. In 1999, Blue and Diane Marcina received *Silver Certificates in Glass-ED and ADA dressage organizations* and won *Reserve High Point and Reserve High Percentage in Glass-Ed Year End Awards*.

In the fall of 1998, Blue entered his first competitive trial ride at Hopkins Creek, won first place overall and since then has rarely finished out of the ribbons. After being ridden in deep leaves in the fall of 1999, a moderate tendon bow occurred in his lower left front leg. Following seven months of rehabilitation and lot of counseling and support from Louise Riedel, Blue was again competing in CTR's.

In October of 2002, Blue became febrile and severely dyspneic. After an incomplete response to antibiotics and steroids, he received five months of ventilpulmin. He was moved to a small heated well-ventilated barn where he recovered.

Indigo Moon has received the following year-end awards in *GLDRA*: 200 miles (1999), 500 miles (2001), 1,000 miles (2003), 6th Limited Distance (2000), 4th Limited Distance (2001), 5TH extended Distance (2002) and 3rd Extended Distance (2003). In *UMECRA*, Blue reached 1,000 miles in 2003 and was in the top six in restricted mileage (Lightweight Competitive) in 2001. Blue has received ribbons in two forty-mile competitive trail rides in Petoskey.

Indigo Moon is intelligent, athletic, resilient and fun to ride with his huge trot that approaches 15 miles per hour. For me, Blue is a great horse and has given me the ride of my life!
