Dianne Kuhn reported that the Annual Meeting will be January 14-15, 2005 at the Howard Johnson Hotel & Conference Center, Antiqua Bay Waterpark, Wisconsin Dells. New Business:	
Darlene Molitor reported on Ken Meyer's Protest of the Spirit Mountain Ride. Darlene reported that Ken Meyer rode a two-day 60-mile competitive ride. He completed the ride at 2pm and at 10 pm that night his horse was treated for choke. A week later, at another ride, Ken asked the Spirit Mountain point-keeper how he had done at the ride, and she said that he was disqualified because his horse was treated. The circumstances of this protest were mailed out to the Board Members in September. Results of polling the Board upholds rule F number 2c under Competitive Rules which states: "Competitive horses shall be certified for completion if they: Have not required and/or received medication for any metabolic reasons before leaving the grounds (to include colic, tying up, thumps, etc.) Any medication administered on the grounds must be under the supervision of a veterinarian. EXCEPTION: Mileage but not placing shall be allowed for a horse that has passed the final check but needs metabolic treatment after that check." Discussion followed: A show of hands gave Ken credit for mileage for the ride and the ride has been placed on probation.	Spirit Mountain Ride Protest
Dianne Kuhn reported that Jill Feller mailed a request for a Trail Fund donation. The Board approved a \$250 donation to the Northern Kettle Moraine Ride. <i>Trail Ride Association % Jill Feller</i>	Trail Fund Donation
Dianne Kuhn made a motion that current UMECRA members be assessed a \$10 penalty fee for dues paid after March 1 (there will be a 30 day grace period in 2005 making them due by April 1). Darlene Molitor seconded. Discussion followed. Dianne Kuhn reported that in reading through old minutes the following rules had been established: In minutes from 1973 a motion was made and seconded to have the yearly dues due on March 1. Further, minutes from 1977 under IV. Membership, Section 1 reads: Membership in this organization shall be limited to active members only. Roberta Harms opened a discussion regarding Ride Liability Insurance -- AERC will not be charging for this insurance. However, this insurance will not cover our Competitive rides. Peggy Brush volunteered to research insurance for the Competitive Rides, and she or her husband will give a report at the Annual Meeting.	Competitive Ride Liability Insurance
Dianne Kuhn made a motion to define the junior division in the Competitive Ride Category as 16 and under as of December 1 of the previous year. Joyce Mocilan seconded. Motion carried.	Competitive Jr Division Age Change
Dale Lunde went through rule change requests submitted by Theresa Meyer. UMECRA Rules J Delete "A person can compete as a novice only on his or her first or second ride." This was a rule deleted at an annual meeting at least 2 years ago. Dale Lunde made the motion for the following addition to the rules, Rick Nelson seconded: General Rules --Management Requirements --D Add italic portion D. Ride management and the ride veterinarian may make alterations to the announced criteria if trail and/or weather conditions warrant it. However, any changes must be made and announced prior to the ride or may be announced at any point on the trail as long as they apply equally to all riders. Discussion followed, motion was defeated. Dale Lunde made the motion & Rick Nelson seconded -- add the following rule under • General Rules F & G. F. The equine may not have received medical treatment by veterinarian or layman prior to the final exam or within two hours of the completion of the ride any equine that a ride veterinarian advised should be treated for a metabolic or soundness problem, but treatment is refused by the rider or owner, shall be considered in the same light as a treated equine and will be disallowed completion. G. The rider/owner of an equine disqualified by a ride veterinarian shall be notified immediately by that veterinarian or the ride manager. Discussion followed, amendment was made to motion F was defeated Change G was accepted and changed to General Rules F. General Rules -- Rider Requirements --4A A. Fix typo "Ferrier" should be "farrier"	Rule Changes Delete UMECRA Rules J

• Dale made the motion, Rick seconded: Rider Requirements - 4C B. The same unit (horse, rider and equipment weight) must be maintained throughout the ride, and must travel the entire trail together. <i>Add On the trail, no other person may lead or ride the horse once the competition has started under penalty of elimination. Motion was defeated</i> • Dale made the motion, Rick seconded: Move Endurance Rule 2C (The rider/owner of an equine disqualified... Ride manager." to General Rules F. Motion carried. • Dale made the motion, Rick seconded to add the italicized text to Endurance Rules -- 9A1 1. All horses must stand <i>for</i> a mandatory post ride evaluation within one hour of finishing. Riders may present their horses for the final examination at a time of their choosing during the one-hour period. A horse that does not meet the established criteria within one hour of crossing the finish line shall be disqualified. Once a competing horse has passed the post ride examination, it may not be removed from completion for veterinary reasons. (AERC only) No horse certified for UMECRA completion if it has <i>received medical treatment by veterinarian or layman prior to the final exam or within two hours of the completion of the ride. Any equine that a ride veterinarian advises should be treated for a metabolic or soundness problem, but treatment is refused by the rider or owner shall be considered in the same light as a treated equine and be disallowed completion.</i> Such horse/rider combination may still received AERC points and mileage credit. Motion was defeated. • Under #8 Endurance Completion Criteria A2. Delete "in documented extreme weather conditions." The next sentence should read per rule change of Jan 2004 at convention "The <i>minimum</i> pulse rate criteria shall be 60" No motion needed.

Dale moved that we print the AERC Ride card instead of the current UMECRA card the next time they are printed up. Bonnie seconded. Discussion followed. Motion carried.	Endurance Ride Card
Linda Mowrer reported that Wayne Gastfield asked that the Ride Manager's Handbook be updated. Updates include: • All endurance rules in Ride Manager's book read that a rider may present his horse within 30 minutes. • Pulse criteria should be changed from "maximum" to "minimum" pulse rate criteria shall be 60. • Limited Distance Rules should read. Order of finish to be determined by time horse reaches a pulse of 60. Horse must be presented within 30 minutes. • Under Heavyweights, change heavyweights "must weigh" to "may be required."
